

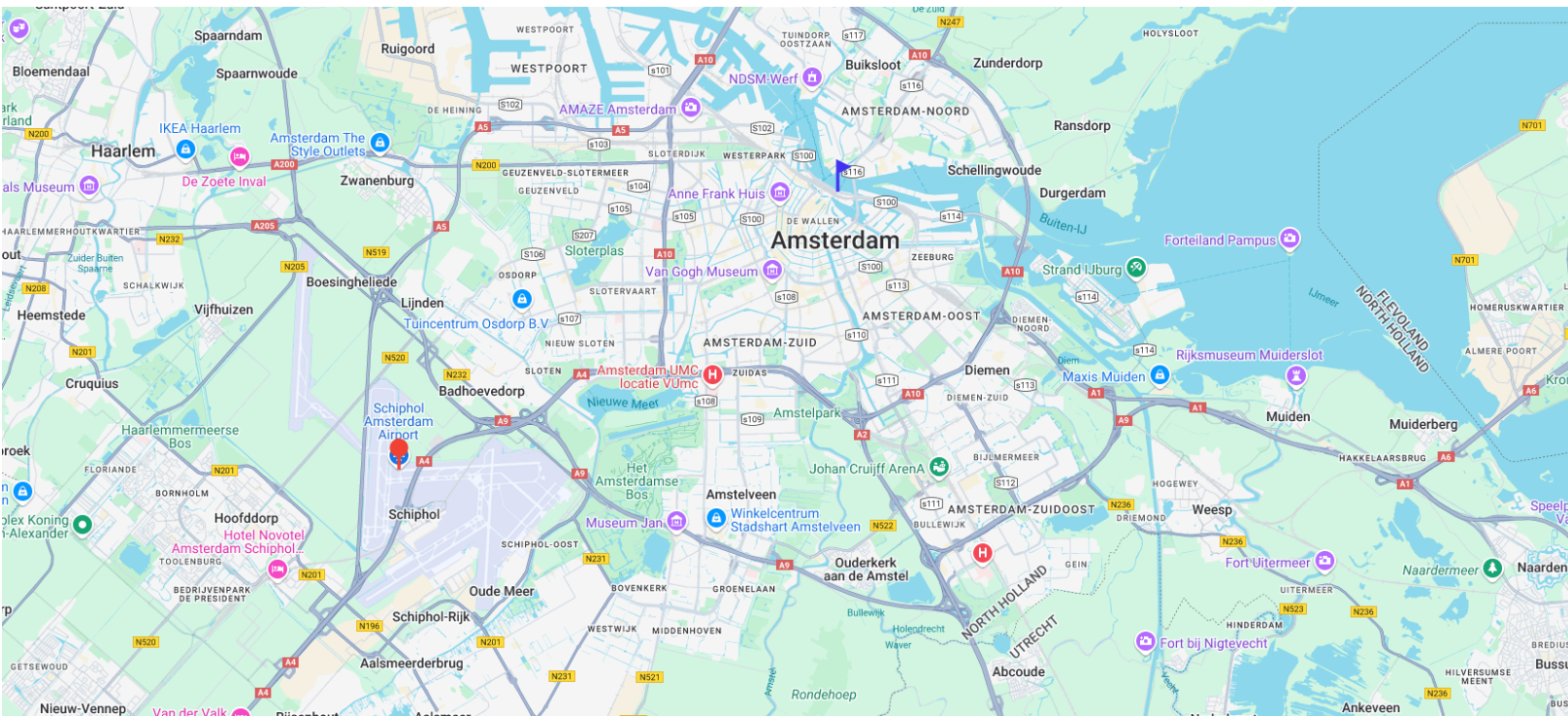


Cruising from Amsterdam

Flying in

Amsterdam Airport Schiphol.

Located just 20 minutes from central Amsterdam, Schiphol Airport (AMS) is the main gateway for cruises departing from Amsterdam. The airport is well-connected to both the city center and the cruise terminal via various transportation options. For Hotels we recommend staying towards the north end of the Nieuwmarkt en Lastage neighborhood.

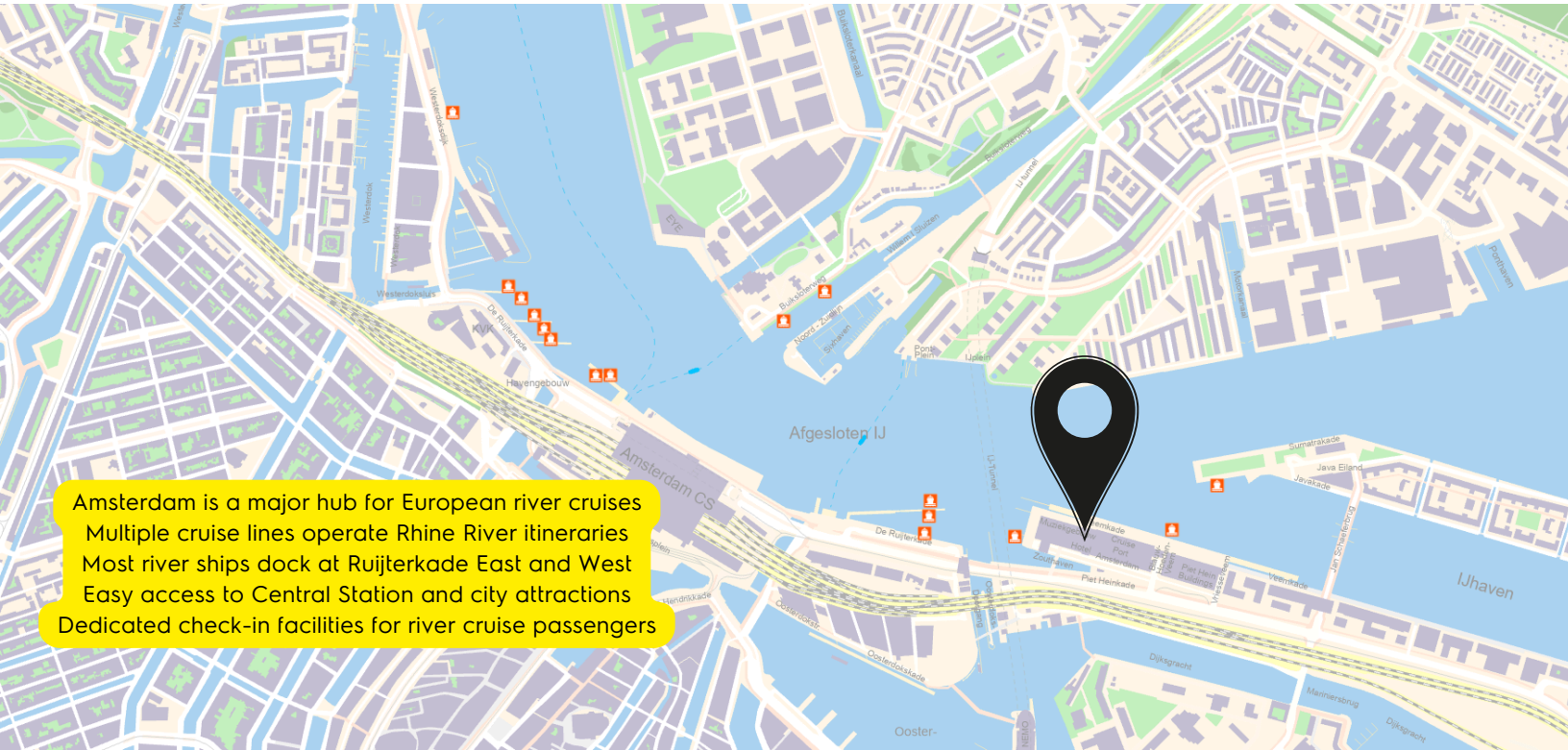


Amsterdam Cruise Terminals

Anne Frank House

The Anne Frank House is a poignant museum dedicated to the life and legacy of Anne Frank. Visitors can explore the hidden annex where Anne and her family hid from the Nazis during World War II, as well as learn about the Holocaust and the importance of tolerance and human rights.



Van Gogh Museum

The Van Gogh Museum houses the largest collection of Vincent van Gogh's paintings and drawings in the world. Visitors can admire his iconic works, such as "Starry Night" and "Sunflowers," and gain insight into his life and artistic journey.



Keukenhof Gardens

Zaanse Schans
