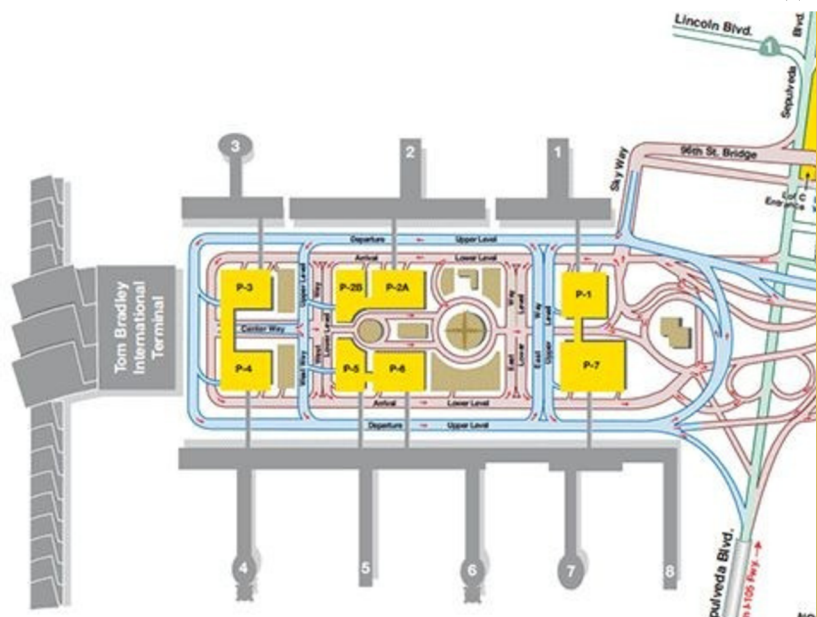




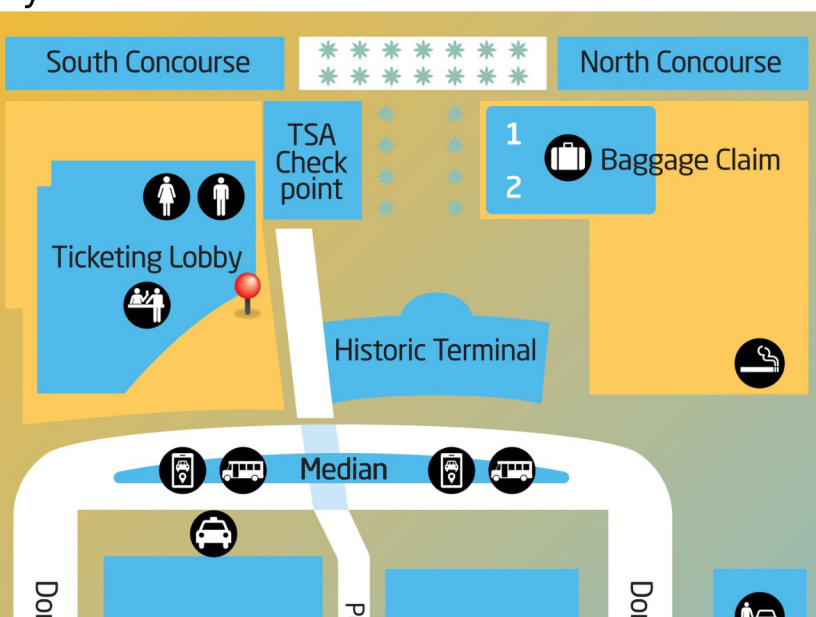
Cruising out of Los Angeles and Long Beach

Flying in to LA / Long Beach

Flying in to Los Angeles for your cruise departing from either the LA or Long Beach ports you will either be flying into LAX or LGB (Long Beach). LAX is roughly 35-45 minutes away from the two ports where LGB is 20-25 minutes away.

With 9 Terminals LAX is a sprawling airport with a main center road section.

For Taxis and rideshare pickup you will need to get to the LAX-IT lot. Shuttles are outside of each terminal and run continuously to the lot. Look for the green LAX-IT Signs. Once there you can be picked up by a taxi, uber, lyft, etc.

Hotel shuttles and other shuttles will be outside of each terminal. For rental vehicles you will look for shuttles next to the purple rental car sign located outside of each terminal.

LGB makes it incredibly easy to find your ride.

Once you exit the Airport your rideshare will be able to pick you up at the center curb. For Taxis you will see a line of them across the street to the right. Shuttles will be in the center lane as well!

Hotel options are best if you are staying near either of the airports or downtown Long Beach.

San Pedro Cruise Terminal (Los Angeles)



San Pedro has two cruise terminals located right next to each other. The two berths (92 and 93) can be used by any of the cruise lines operating out of San Pedro.

Parking is available on site and is free for the first hour. After that, it is \$2 per hour with a 20\$ daily max.

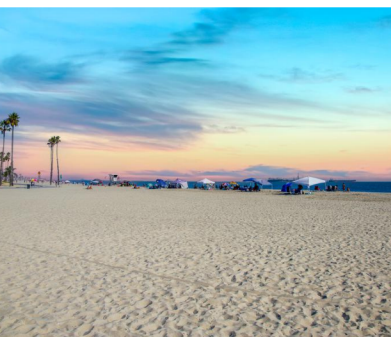
Long Beach Cruise Terminal

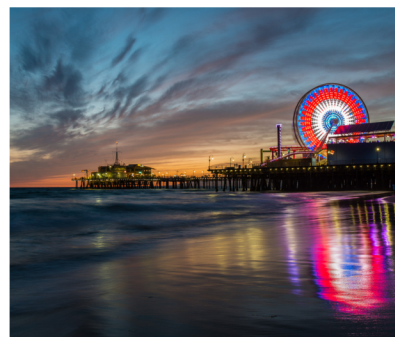
Beach Day
