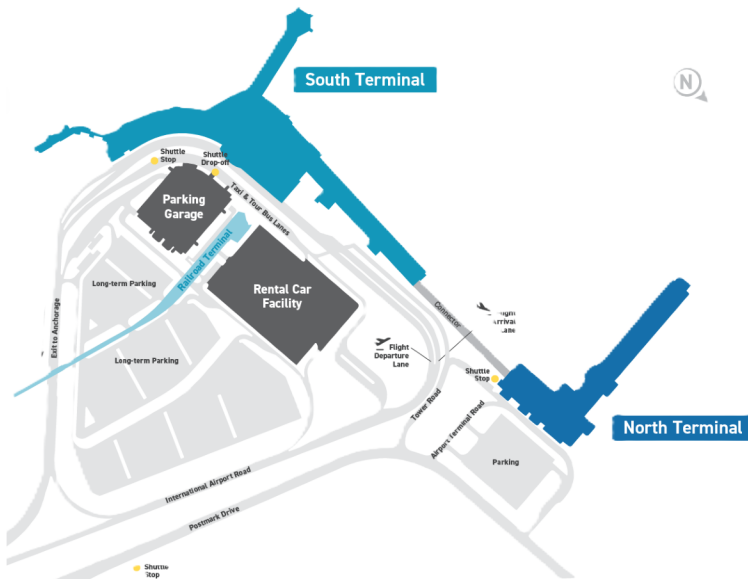




Departing From Whittier, AK

Flying in to Whittier



When cruising out of Whittier Cruise Port you will be flying into Anchorage Airport (ANC). From the airport you are roughly 75 minutes away from the cruise terminal. With there being few lodging options in Whittier itself we recommend to stay in Anchorage in either Mid-Town or Downtown properties. After you land at Anchorage to find your ride of choice you can do one of the following. For Taxis, if you are in the Southern Terminal, you can walk outside of the baggage claim area and get one from the arrivals curb. From the North Terminal you will go outside from the baggage claim area across from Door 2. Shuttles will be outside of baggage claim in both terminals. For rental vehicles in the Southern Terminal you will need to take the stairs, elevator, or escalator down to level 0 and follow the signs for rental cars. Keep in mind that the walk through this tunnel is over 100 yards long. From the North Terminal you would take the free shuttle outside baggage claim. If the shuttle is not there you can call to request the shuttle by using the wall mounted phone adjacent to the terminal connector. You can also call 907-677-1074 from your cell phone.

Using a transfer service like ACT Big Bus which will pick you up both at the hotel and the airport is a good option.

Space on the train to Whittier is limited and more expensive and taking a taxi would be extremely expensive

Lodging

When it comes to hotels and lodging we recommend that you stay in Anchorage proper in either the Mid-Town or Downtown locations. While there are a few properties in Whittier they tend to be more expensive and there is less to do in Whittier than Anchorage.
